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1. Overview of National co-financing systems

Under the South East Europe Transnational Cooperation Programme, projects are co-financed by ERDF and IPA. **The co-financing rate per partner is 85,00 %.** The remaining budget (at least 15,00 %) has to be covered by national contribution, brought in by each project partner.

This document contains **summary information on the national co-financing systems** for the following reason:

State contribution has to be indicated in the Application Form **only in case the partner state provides by automatic or by specific calls national public contribution at state level** for the project selected by the Monitoring Committee, and therefore **the amount covered by state contribution will be reimbursed to the project partner.**

The national contribution of the **ERDF/IPA project partners** can be covered by the following sources:

- **state contribution** and/or
- own public contribution of the project partner and/or
- other public contribution (e.g. regional/local/other public sources).

Please note, that this document is prepared only for information purposes and does not constitutes part of the 3rd and 4th Call for proposals.

AUSTRIA DOES NOT PROVIDE STATE CONTRIBUTION AUTOMATICALLY

Due to the fact that the system of national co-financing in Austria is organised in a decentralised way, every Austrian project partner has to take care of his/her national co-financing funds by himself/herself. Accordingly, prospective Austrian partners should contact relevant authorities at national, regional or local level on time (well ahead the submission of the Application Form).

Public bodies or bodies governed by public law can use their own resources as national co-financing in case their financial resources consist of public funds.

The legal basis, the procedure, the time schedule & the financing flows are depending on the respective source and are usually based on specific decisions (of ministries, regions, etc.) on the respective amount of funds. There is no central regulation on this matter.

Description of the national co-financing system:

Bulgarian project partners participating in the South East Europe transnational cooperation programme will be granted national co-financing by the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works.

According to the Manual for the Participation of the Republic of Bulgaria in the SEE Programme and to the Internal Rules for Contracting of Grants for the National Co-financing of Bulgarian Project Partners in Projects under SEE Programme all Bulgarian partners may request the national co-financing after the signature of Subsidy Contract between the SEE JTS and the LP.

After a subsidy contract for national co-financing between the Ministry of Regional Development and Public Works and the Bulgarian partner is signed 80% of the amount shall be transferred as advance payment. Final balance of the national co-financing will be paid following the authorisation of final reimbursement of ERDF to the project partner concerned.

Description of the national co-financing system:

The Greek National Co-Financing is disbursed to the Greek Partners with approved projects through the Public Investments Fund Programme. Resources from the Public Investments Fund are committed yearly based on data communicated by the Managing Authority of European Territorial Cooperation Programmes of Greece.

Greek project partners are required to submit an inquiry to the Managing Authority of European Territorial Cooperation Programmes of Greece requesting the registration of their project to the Public Investments Fund Programme. Along with their inquiry, Greek Project Partners must submit the following documents:

- i. A copy of the approved application form
- ii. A copy of the Subsidy Contract
- iii. A copy of the Partnership Agreement

Once the approved documents have been submitted, the MA of ETC Programmes of Greece provides its consent for funding. A copy of this letter is provided to the project partner concerned. In order to receive payment, project partners must validate their expenses and submit a letter, to the MA of ETC Programmes of Greece, of application requesting the national co-financing. This procedure is repeated until the end of the project duration.

(1) The following **organizations** shall receive 15% national co-financing (beside the 85% ERDF) within the subsidy content of the project part of the respective partner:

A) Central budgetary organisations financed from state budget:

- a) ministries and budgetary organisations under their supervision;
- b) organisations possessing a chapter in the central budget and budgetary organisations under their supervision;
- c) other organisations possessing chapteral rights defined in separate laws and budgetary organisations under their supervision.

B) Other beneficiaries financed from state budget listed in ESA'95.

In the case of these organisations, the national co-financing shall be increased by the eventual 5% own contributions if the partner planned so in the application. However, the maximum amount of support cannot exceed the limit defined in the CfP (if any).

According to CIPE (Interministerial Committee for Economic Programming) Decision n. 36 15/06/2007, the share of National Public co-financing for cross-border, transnational and interregional Cooperation Programmes to which part and/or the whole Italian territory is eligible, managed by Public Authorities, is guaranteed by the National Rotation Fund, established by art 5 of Law 183/1987. Resources from the Rotation Fund are committed yearly to each of the above mentioned Cooperation Programmes by a Decree of the Ministry of Economy and Finance, based on data communicated by the Ministry for Economic Development.

Financial flows

After receiving ERDF reimbursements, Italian PPs and LPs shall address to the Ministry for Economic Development - DPS their claims for the reimbursement of the corresponding national share of co-financing.

After verifying the correctness of the claim, DPS will forward the claim to the Ministry of Economy and Finance - IGRUE, which will actually pay the national co-financing to Italian PPs and LPs.
